DLFF CEC (High School) Scholars
2024-2025 School Year

10 hours of service are required by the DLFF CEC (High School) Scholars. The requirements are as follows:

- A minimum of 8 service hours performed with their DLFF Service Team
- A minimum of 2 *Initiative* service hours from the DLFF Scholar Calendar
- Complete at least one type of community advocacy for chosen cause or partner

DLFF Tracking Form

All scholars that complete a service project are **required** to submit a tracking form in order to receive credit from DLFF. This form is used to calculate our scholars' impact in the community. We feel it is important to reflect on the amazing work our scholars are doing. We regularly share stories of impact via our Scholar Spotlights as well as statistics on website/social media including total number of hours given to the community, groups helped and our partner connections. 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Photos for Tracking Form

A photo or selfie is **required to be taken at each service event**. A group photo of yourself with other DLFF scholars will be accepted as well. Please do not include any non-DLFF children or adults. Photos will be used for future DLFF marketing; therefore they must be appropriate and show your full face. Please only upload one photo with your form submission. Additional photos can be emailed to Mrs. Lynch (pam@dlff.org). A photo is required to submit a DLFF tracking form.

Independent Projects

This year DLFF will offer opportunities for our scholars to lead independent projects with a partner pre-approved by DLFF. These projects will require a scholar leader to plan all steps for the project and meet with Mrs. Lynch regularly to check in on deadlines. Scholar leaders can choose up to two other DLFF scholars to join their team.

Advocacy

In the spring, service-learning will continue for the DLFF Scholars. All Scholars will be required to take part in an advocacy campaign for a cause (or partner) of their choice. DLFF Leaders and Mrs. Lynch will advertise various opportunities and will help guide the Scholars. Our goal with this program is to show the Scholars that there are a variety of ways to support the community and our partners.

Reflection-Service Learning

To further enrich the community service experience, DLFF Scholars will be required to journal about their volunteer experience. Journal prompts will be assigned to scholars by Service Team Leaders and should be completed immediately. Journal entries will be shared during group discussions facilitated by the Service Team Leader.

All Scholar Service Days

DLFF will host opportunities for our Pathway and DLFF CEC Scholars to volunteer together. This year we will be working with The United Way HELP Center and Rolling Harvest Food Rescue. These events are a great way to meet other scholars and work together. All Scholar Days will be listed on the DLFF Scholar Calendar and count towards Initiative Hours.
