

## DLFF Service Requirements DLFF/CEC (High School) Scholars

10 hours of service are required by the DLFF CEC (High School) Scholars for the 2023-2024 school year. The requirements are as follows:

- A minimum of 8 service hours performed with their DLFF Service Team
- A minimum of 2 service hours completed with an approved community partner\*
